## Abstract

Historically, Sasi culture was created by Mollucan ancestor as a local custom in the sanction form to the Mollucan people, to take the harvest of the forest and sea in the certain time. The sanction is not limited for the owner but also for others to take it without having permition from the owner. Since the Christianity came to Mollucan, Sasi Culture was almost destructed because it was assumed that Sasi was taboo and had magical element based on the Christian theology.
